Dr. Rita Ahuja has always been an inspiration to the students and alumni of NBGSM College. It was a memorable day of September 05th 1981 i.e. the occasion of Teacher's Day when she joined as an Assistant Professor in Commerce. Now, she has completed her tenure of more than 37 years in NBGSM College, Sohna and retired as an Associate Professor in Commerce in August 2018. *Campus Chronicles* caught up with her and asked about her lifetime experience as a teacher. During the interview, she felt nostalgic about the many good memories she had in this college and the emotions were running down from her eyes.

As you are going to bid adieu to this Journey you must be feeling nostalgic. How will you describe your Journey at NBGSM College?

It's been quite a roller-coaster ride, and there were so many ups and down in this whole journey. I have not only played the role of a teacher in students' life, but the responsibility of the Head of Commerce Department also came my way. It is natural to feel emotional at this time, as I have spent more than 37 years in this college. During the initial days, there were some problems in interacting with the students. Being a teacher it was my utmost duty to give my best to my students. Believe me, I have learnt a lot while teaching them. I have fond memories of each class that I taught during this period. I spent my time with my colleagues as a family and they were very supportive. I am very thankful to Commerce Department for their precious and valuable guidance without which this journey could not have been so smooth.

What do you think matters the most for a teacher?

In my opinion, education should be job oriented. A teacher should think deeply on this subject and utilize teaching methodologies, which are more focused towards developing the skills in the students, much required in the current job scenario. A teacher-student's relationship must be approachable and they must work towards a common goal of attaining perfection through creative learning and capacity enhancement by involving in curricular and extracurricular activities as well.

With the rapid changes in technology, you must have seen changes in the education sector as well. How were you able to cope-up with these changes?

With ever-increasing technology, substantial amount of changes has been seen in education sector. To cope up with these changes, upto date knowledge in your teaching subject is necessary. A teacher must include habits such as book reading, newspaper reading, subject related journals, etc. in his/her schedule. In addition, they must enhance their own academic potential by attending workshops and faculty development programmes in order to enhance the quality of education.

Do you think that it is important to accept the changes in teaching pedagogy?

Changes in Teaching Pedagogy is necessary. Orientation and seminars on teaching pedagogy must not only be organized for the teachers but for students as well. In my opinion, everyone should accept these changes and adapt accordingly.

Tell me something about a few positive things, which were beyond your expectations?

When I joined the college, the Principal's support was unexpected. He supported me a lot in growing my personality. Being the HOD it always scared me that how will I handle the staff requirements. But with the help of the principal and his continuous guidance I was able to fairly handle their complaints and concerns with

dignity and respect. I have always welcomed and appreciated the staff diverse perspectives, ideas, and work style of my staff and this has helped me a lot in achieving the success in this whole Journey. My family support also was much unexpected. Principal Dr. M.S. Khatri was also very co-operative and supportive. Last, but not the least, I did not expect that my students would love me so much.

You are leaving behind lots of memories that you have collected in NBGSM College, What advice/message would you like to communicate to your colleagues.

One should not get frustrated whatsoever. Struggles and hardships enhances our experience in that particular field and makes us stronger than before. If you work hard, consistently and persistently, certainly you will find good result in the end. Socialize and have good relations with everyone. As the saying goes "If you want to walk fast, walk alone. But If you want to walk far, walk together". Always be grateful and thankful to God for what you have, there is always someone out there who wishes that they had what you have.
