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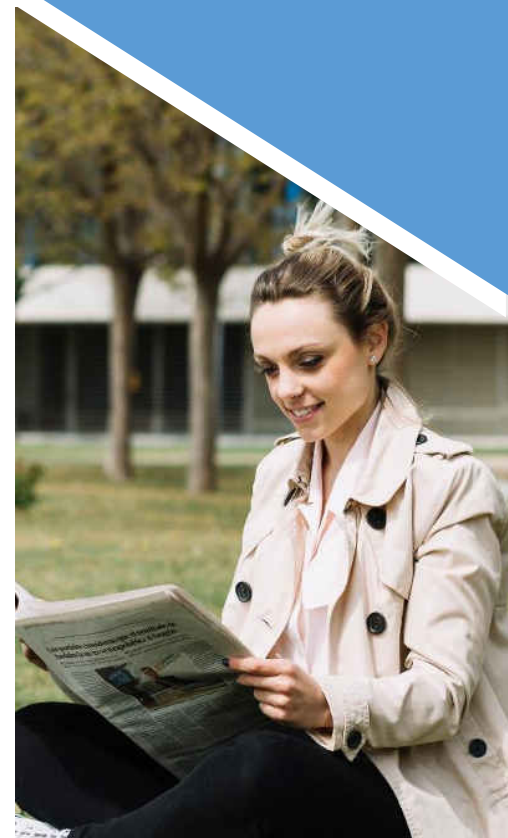

KNOW YOUR LEADERS

Mr. Rishi Gupta

Judicial Magistrate / Civil Judge

Alumni of N.B.G.S.M. College

“Mr. Rishi Gupta, is a Judicial Magistrate/Civil Judge, currently posted in Motihari district under High Court, Patna. He is an alumnus of our college, B.Com. (Pass) 2004 pass out residing at Lohiya wada, Sohna. His father Shri N.K. Gupta was a Bank Manager and all the other members in his family are businessperson.”

Team: Dear sir, it is our privilege to have a conversation with an alumnus of our college who is not only attained a respectable position in society but also an inspiration to the students. Would you please share your journey from the NBGSM College to a Civil Judge.

Mr. Rishi: My journey from NBGSM college to a judge is more than a dream come true since till the end of B.Com. 1st year I was just an average student, be it in studies or in sports. It is the guidance of my teachers specially Monga Sir and Kashyap sir that has encouraged me to perform better. I am grateful to my friends for their constant support by which I have gathered a lot of confidence and has led to a paradigm shift. In sports, I became part of a badminton team which in the first time in history of our college has reached to the finals in zonal level.

Team: According to you, what is the most effective strategy to achieve a goal successfully?

Mr. Rishi: Well, the strategy adopted by me is not something that we are unaware of, but in student life, we are distracted and tend to ignore these.

According to me, to achieve any goal, we must have a highest level of dedication (not desperation) which shall necessary be followed by hard work and persistent effort. We must self-introspect and

find out our weaknesses and work on those at once. We must have patience and self-discipline, as mere academic exams is not sufficient to have a successful career ahead.

Team: Mr. Rishi, could you please elaborate here how self-discipline plays an important role in life and how do you maintain self-discipline?

Mr. Rishi: Certainly, maintaining self-discipline is an important thing to achieve any goal. When I left for Delhi to prepare for the competitive exam of judicial service in 2008, I was in full rhythm in my studies, my dedication was at apex level where I unconditionally wanted to be a judge. I almost left attending parties, ceremonies and all other programs and disciplined myself to have complete focus towards my goal. This level of dedication I think becomes my self-discipline which in fact I never tried to maintain manually.

Team: Would you describe the most challenging ethical dilemma you have encountered and how did you handled it?

Mr. Rishi: Well, I was lucky enough to not face any ethical dilemma as of yet, but yes, I have faced a factual dilemma when after three years I was unable to crack the judicial examination despite all my efforts. At that point of time my family, specially my father and my brother has backed me like anything and gave me freedom to fight this competition and not to give up. Where many left this competition after elapse of such time, I have not given up. You can now see where I am today.

Team: You must have been dealing with too many priorities matter. How do you cope with it?

Mr. Rishi: Indeed, I have. However, when I opted this line I was clear in my mind about my goal and how much attention it requires. My job is my priority and when one is specific about his priority, there is no dilemma in dealing with it.

Team: What do you miss from your student days?

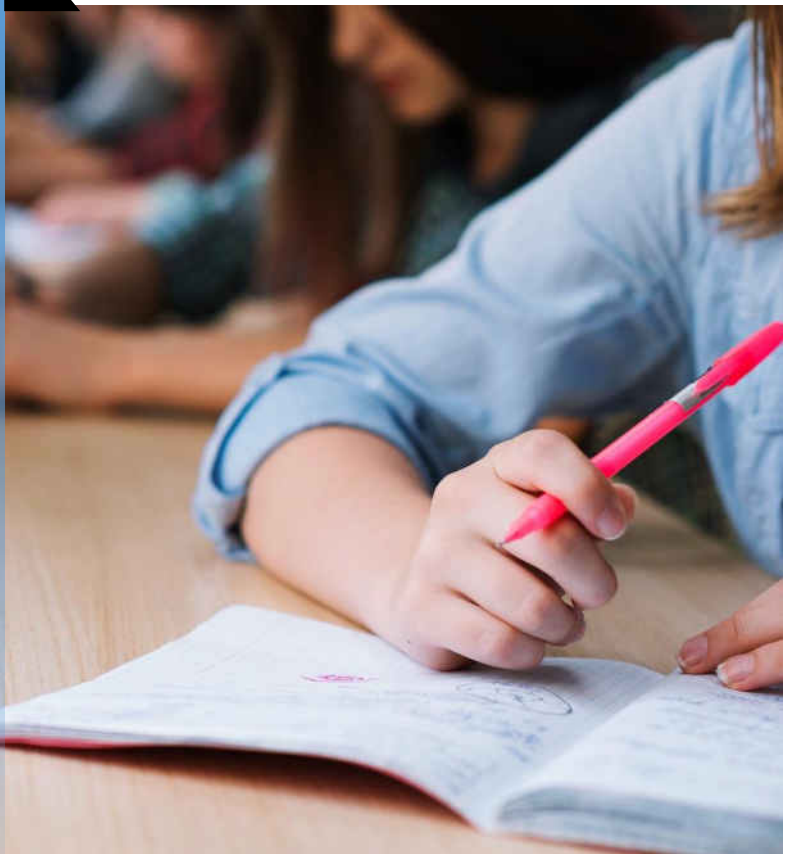

Competitions as well as in sports (Badminton, to be specific) but as a student I was reluctant to participate in extra-curricular activities. I probably miss that time and wish I could have participated in these activities as well.

Mr. Rishi: Dear friends, some of you have began your college journey and some of you are about to graduate and looking for various prospects after graduation. Some of you may be in a dilemma and hesitant to join in a company far from your home. Some of your friends may have decided to pursue higher education and gain further knowledge and understanding about their respective subject. Here, I would like to advice that one shall first understand and identify one's capabilities and interest and then only proceed towards a particular career / higher education. Moreover, never think that it's an ending phase of your career; just give yourself few more years in that chosen course or competitive exams, your efforts will not go in vain. I wish you all a great and enlightening career ahead!
