Minutes of IQAC meeting held on 06/04/2014

The meeting of IQAC was held on 06/04/2014 at 11:00 A.M. in the office of the Principal in which the following members were present:-

A meeting of the IQAC was held on 06th April 2014 to assess the suggestion / advice made by IQAC in its meeting dated 22nd Sept. 2013 and to realize the developments made by the college in the academic year 2013-14.

1. The IQAC expressed a general satisfaction over the implementation of calendar of activities by various departments of the college. The performance is satisfactory comparative to the envisioned plan at the beginning of the academic session.
2. The annual result of the college was acknowledged and it was found that 15 students were placed in M.D University, Rohtak merit list. In addition, 158 students got 1st division in their results. The IQAC not only expressed satisfaction but applauded the efforts and hard work made by

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
the staff and co-operation entered by the management committee of the college.

3. College representation in various events at Zonal Youth Festival organized by M.D. University, Rohtak was shown in 27 events, in which 49 students participated. Our college team stood 2nd in Group Dance (General) and Best out of waste. The IQAC appreciated the efforts made by the cultural affairs committee of the college which has put a good show by mobilizing students and motivating them to participate.

The performance of the NCC unit of the college was observed as 25 students have been awarded C certificates by participating in various training camps and activities organized by the college units in association with Indian Army unit, Gurgaon which is assigned with the task to train NCC cadets in colleges.
5. The management accepted the proposal made by the IQAC and started demolishing the old building in order to rebuild it with greater facilities.
6. As requested by the IQAC in its meeting dated 22 Sept. 2013, the management of the college acted proactively to fulfill the requirement of the college in making available the internet facility.
7. As recommended, a Convocation Function was organized on 05th March, 2014 to appreciate the efforts made by the students.
8. The Management has also been very helpful in taking up the matter of renovating the stage.
9. As requested by the IQAC, tile flooring was done in the college administrative block, Principal office and management office.
10. A Genset of 100 KV was procured to meet the requirement of uninterrupted power supply.
11. In addition, CCTV surveillance systems along with 58 CCTV Cameras were installed in the college campus as suggested by the IQAC.
12. To maintain the attendance record of the teaching/non-teaching staff, a Biometric record keeping machine was installed at the entrance gate of the administrative office.

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13. As requested by the IQAC, three servant rooms was also constructed inside the college campus.
 14. The management committee agreed with the recommendation made by the IQAC in making available regular housekeeping staff. So, a contractual service was acquired from Efficient Housekeeping services.
 15. Towards the end of the session, an extra classes for weak students were organized by various departments (As and where required).

The IQAC applauded the efforts made by the Management committee in proactively accomplishing the infrastructural requirements of the college and expressed gratefulness.

The meeting ended with happy note and a vote of thanks to the chair.
