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
Minutes of IQAC meeting held on 27-09-2015

The meeting of IQAC was held on 27-09-2015 at 11:00 A.M. in the office of the Principal. The following members were present:-

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1. The calendar of activities prepared by various departments was submitted to the IQAC and everyone present in the meeting applauded the efforts being made by the college and ratified it.
 2. The academic results of various courses undergoing in the college for the academic session 2014-15 were put before the IQAC and everyone expressed their satisfaction in general terms.
 3. Prof. Ravinder Vinayak recommended that a new course should be introduced in the college, specifically in the area of science. The committee further resolved that M.D. University can be approached for a new course for instance B.Sc. (Non-medical).
 4. The case of Dr. D.P. Singh, Assistant Professor in English was submitted to the committee & considered his case for selection grade. But, Dr. D.P. Singh

submitted a request to the DGHE with a copy to the Principal to consider his case for the grant of benefit of his past services that he rendered in this college as Assistant Professor in English w.e.f. 31-07-2004 to 01-12-2006. Hence, the committee decided to defer his case till the decision to give benefit of his past services is taken by the management and DGHE.

5. With the introduction of a course in science it was found appropriate to setup a Chemistry as well as Physics lab for the same.
6. In addition, the committee recommended setup the labs with instruments and items which are considered essential for smooth functioning of the Chemistry and Physics lab experiments.
7. With the creation of a Nirankari Vocational Centre in college campus, the IQAC recommended to introduce more courses along with the basic computer knowledge course.
8. The IQAC suggested that for the overall development of the students, it is important that the college provide a playing ground having a running track of 200 meters. They further requested that the management can be approached for the same.
9. In addition, the green area inside the college campus can be improved for a better view point of the college.
10. Dr. S.P. Monga raised the point that a separate transformer should be made available for the college to maintain uninterrupted power supply.
