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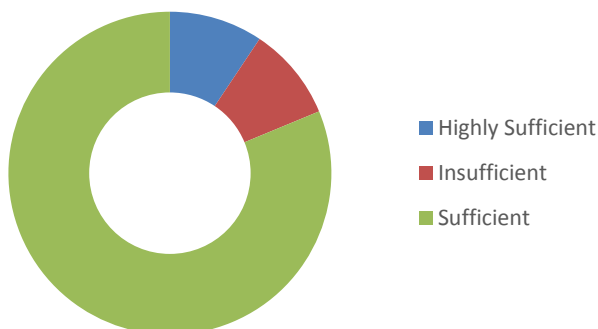

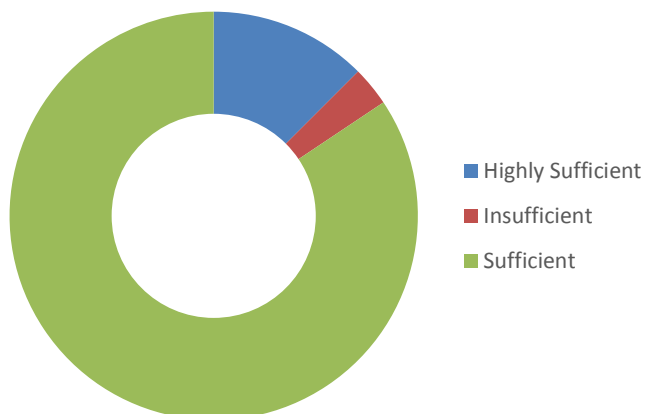

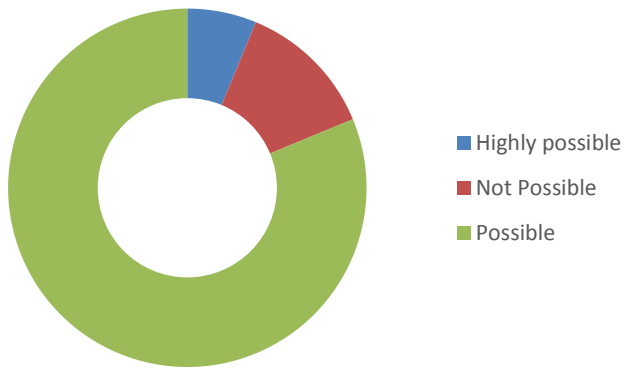
Q1. Is your syllabus sufficient to bridge the gap between industry standards /current global scenarios and academics?



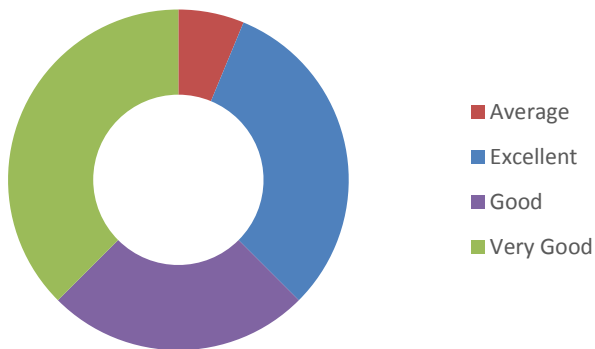
Q2. The evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment?



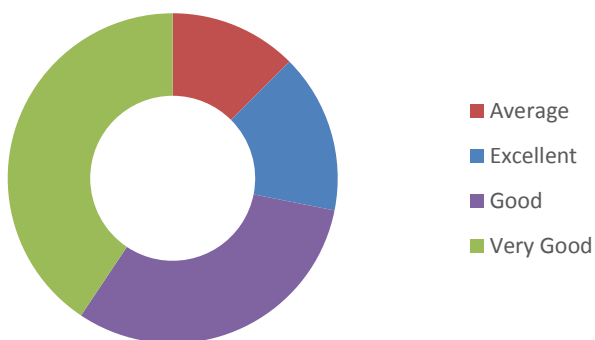
Q3. Is the timely completion of syllabus possible in the mentioned number of hours?



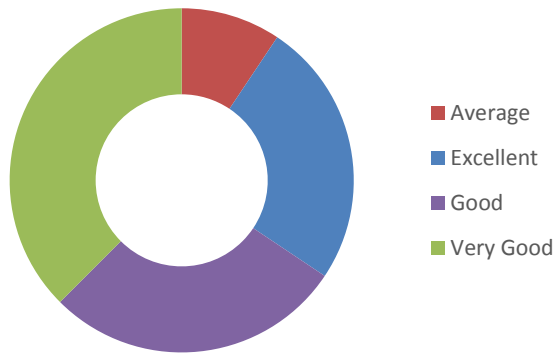

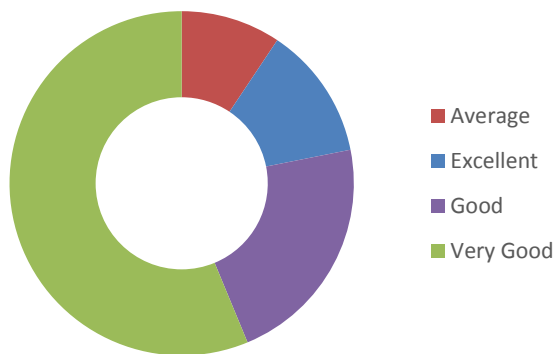

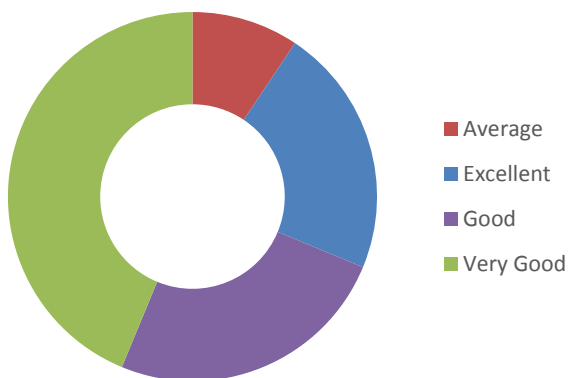

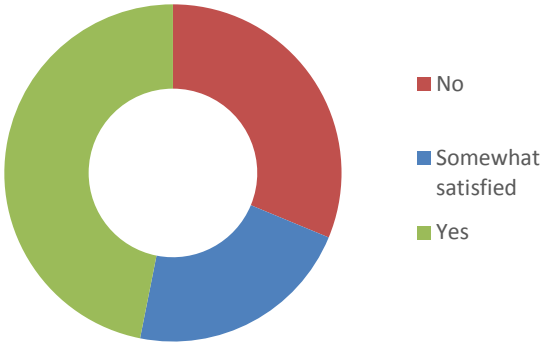
Q10. Any suggestions on improving the teaching-learning process?

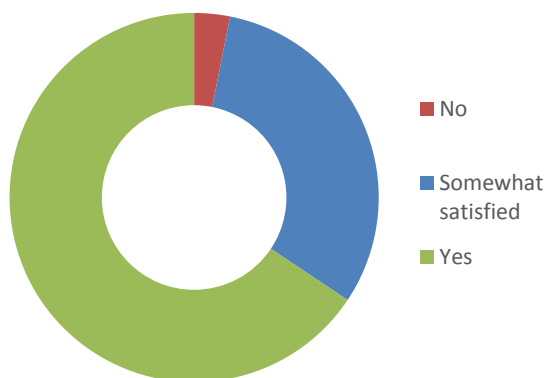

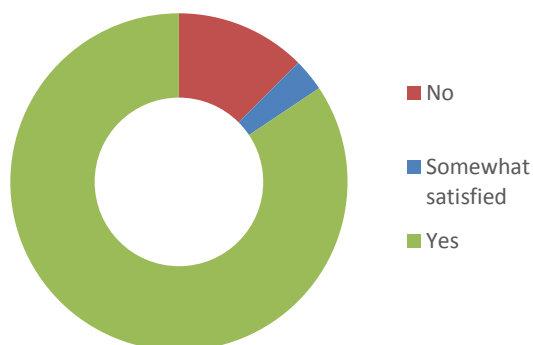
Q12. Are you satisfied with the research journals/ subscriptions of magazines, etc. in the college library?
