In addition to Certificate in Office Automation and Digital Education (COADE), and Diploma in Accounting with Tally (DAT), one more course has been introduced viz. Digital Marketing (DM). In current batch (started from 14 th June 2021), there are 44 students in COADE, 33 in (DAT) and 27 students in DM.

3	Mrs. Raman Manhas advised to prepare a checklist on the modules/task completed under Digitalization of college through ERP and pending issues.	A meeting has been called on to discuss the issues and challenges in the current ERP, and it was found that the company is unable to fulfil the requirement of the college and there are various other challenges which the company is unable to resolve.
